

Rules

Format: Scramble. Teams will be composed of four players either arranged by the participants or established by the Member Fall Mixer Committee.

Each member of the team hits from the tee. The team then chooses the best ball and plays from that spot. Play continues in this manner until the ball is holed. The FIRST ball holed counts for the team's score. NOTE: Each player's tee shot (on any hole) must be used at least one time on the front nine and one time on the back nine of the golf course (as the scorecard reads). Team captains will be responsible for the team following this rule.

Team handicaps will be computed by totaling the individual handicaps on each team and multiplying the total by .125. The maximum individual handicap allowed is 36.

The 14-club rule is waived. CTP is defined as the closest spot of a ball on the green to the pin. If there is a hole-in-one the player must place the marker to the side of the green.

As this is a scramble format, the ball may be moved or placed one club length from tee to green, no closer to the hole. The procedure when playing a ball from a sand bunker is as follows: The first player plays the ball as it lies. Each subsequent player may rake the bunker and place his or her ball in a similar position. NOTE: A ball chosen in the rough must be played from the rough by all team members.

All men except WWII & Korean Vets will hit from the middle tees. WW II & Korean War Vets have the option of hitting from the middle tees or the Connolly tees. All women will hit from the forward tees.

Hazards are marked in RED for lateral hazards and YELLOW for water hazards. Out-of-bounds areas are marked by WHITE stakes and/or defined by street curbs. A ball that crosses a street curb and comes to rest on another part of the golf course is considered out-of-bounds. All newly seeded areas, piles of dirt, ruts and fire ant mounds should be treated as ground under repair. Find the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole with no penalty.

All players are allowed two mulligans which may be used at any time. Team captains will monitor use of mulligans. NOTE: Once a commitment is made to use a mulligan it can not be revoked.

If there is a question regarding a rule, please play a second ball and consult the Rules Committee after play.
