

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING  
ONION CREEK POST 326 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE  
May 28, 2010**

**Commander Ken Baucom called a Special Called Meeting of the Onion Creek Post 326 Executive Committee to order at 1605 hours.**

**Attending were: Ken Baucom, Don Jones, Fred McCarthy, Tony Nuccio, Clyde Walls, Roy Dalton and Vern Thomas. There were no guests.**

**Chairman of the Nominating Committee and Former Commander Roy Dalton reported that the Nominating Committee is recommending the following officers to serve for the years 2010-2011: Commander, Ken Baucom; Vice Commander of Activities, Clyde Walls; Vice Commander of Membership, Don Wyatt; Adjutant, Jerry Prestridge; Finance Officer, Rocky Eubank; Sergeant-at-Arms, Rowland Greenwade; Service Officer, Bob Purcell; Historian, John Vinciguerra; Chaplain, Fred McCarthy; At-Large Committee Members, Mike Rodriguez, Mike Jackson and Don Jones. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed to accept the report of the Nominating Committee.**

**Commander Baucom reported that Don Wyatt is moving out of state and will not be able to serve as Vice Commander of Membership. Commander Baucom reported that Rowland Greenwade will not be available to serve as Sergeant-at-Arms because of health reasons. Commander Baucom reported that after reviewing American Legion manuals and discussions with several other American Legion Posts he recommended changing the Officer sub-titles from Vice Commander Membership to First Vice Commander and Vice Commander of Activities to Second Vice Commander. After general discussion, a motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed to approve Commander Baucom's recommendations.**

**Second Vice Commander will remain open because of Don Wyatt's unavailability. Past Commander Don Jones has requested Mike Jackson to serve as Sergeant-at-Arms and Jackson is considering it. If Jackson serves as Sergeant-at-Arms, member Fred Hannah will be recommended to be an At-Large Committee Member. Commander Baucom will contact Post members about the Second Vice Commander Office with installation in July.**

**Vice Commander Tom Harder will no longer serve as an officer but will remain Chairman of the Membership Committee.**

**Commander Baucom reported that he plans to delineate the duties of the First and Second Vice Commanders in order to better use the skills of the officers and to attain a high level of accountability.**

**Commander Baucom reported that a Flag Retirement Ceremony will be conducted on at 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 14, 2010 at the Creedmoor Café in Creedmoor, Texas. Baucom has**

spoken to Mayor Wilhite, City of Creedmoor and he will participate in the ceremony. The Mayor will be an Honorary Sergeant-at-Arms. The Mayor will ask members of the Creedmoor Volunteer Fire Department to attend. All flags to be retired will be collected from Post 326 members. A burn facility is being constructed by the Clarence Vogel family and will be placed outside the Creedmoor Café. The Sergeant-at-Arms has a prominent role in the ceremony and in his absence Commander Baucom has asked Past Commander Don Jones and Vice Commander Tom Harder to assist in the ceremony. Chaplain Fred McCarthy has a prominent role in the ceremony and will attend. All members of the Post who can participate should meet at the Creedmoor Café prior to five o'clock. Pictures will be taken.

Tony Nuccio, Tom Harder, Don Jones and Roy Dalton have undertaken the job of making all arrangements for the Post General Meeting on June 2, 2010 because Sergeant-at-Arms Rowland Greenwade is not available. Tony Nuccio and Tom Harder have compiled a new database of Post 326 members. Tony Nuccio has sent e-mails to members requesting an RSVP if attending. The new database will be kept up to date. Currently, 63 people will attend, including Scholarship awardees and their parents and the guest speaker and his assistant. OCC will be open Monday, Memorial Day, and closed on Tuesday so reporting the number of dinners to OCC will have to be done by telephone. Robin Baucom will get the name badges from Karen Greenwade and Don Jones will ask Leora McCarthy, Sue Nuccio and Rosemary Irwin to work at the registration table. Credit cards will be handled as they were in the past. Table tent cards will be prepared. Vexillologist John Knox, the guest speaker, will need two tables for the flags he will speak about. Scholarship Chairman Mike Rodriguez will meet and greet the scholarship students and their parents and will seat them. Each member of the Executive Committee attending will host a scholarship student and parents at his table.

Chaplain McCarthy reported there have been no deaths in the Post in the last year. He also requested a moment of silence at the meeting to recognize Memorial Day.

Tony Nuccio will present a slide show of the Golf Tournament during the Social Hour. Also, a table with "grab bag" items left over from the tournament will be set up. Tony has the raffle tickets and jar and Don Jones will conduct the raffle. Team Four of the Golf Tournament gave back the four gift certificates they won. Including the usual raffle items there will probably be seven items in the raffle.

Tony Nuccio requested five minutes of the program to recognize and thank all the volunteers who worked in the Golf Tournament. Tony will also mail a "thank you" letter to all volunteers.

Commander Baucom suggested that seating at the General Meeting begin at 6:45 so that the meeting can begin promptly at 7:00.

There being no further business to come before the Executive Committee, Commander Baucom adjourned the meeting at 1647 hours.
